LITERARY BEGINNINGS

Under the series 'Literary Beginnings,' the publishing house released the first novels, short stories, and poems in the Yemeni literature, including works such as 'Qarout Girl' by Ahmed Abdullah al-Saqqaf (the first novel in Yemen and the Gulf), 'Taahish al-Hawban' by Ziad Muta'a Damaj, and the novel 'Sa'id and Kamla Devi' by Muhammad Ali al-Loqman. The publishing house also released works by pioneers and icons of Yemeni literature and culture, including Abdullah al-Baradoni, Abdulaziz al-Maqalah, Ziad Muta'a Damaj, and other Yemeni and Arab writers.
